

Design, Dye, Print Camp with Adina Marguerite Pease Supply List

Please note that most dye supplies are included in the tuition price for your workshop.

- 2" Soft Rubber Brayer
- Basic Block Carving Tool(s)
 - This is a great starter set. If you have other brands, that's okay as well just be sure to have a few different shapes; U's & V's, and sizes.
- Barren
- 2 3x4" Speedy Carve Blocks
 - Please get the pink Speedball brand Speedy Carve blocks only if you bring another brand/type of block it may not lend itself well to fabric printing. If you need to get another size block that's alright - you can easily cut it down to size!
- Speedball Fabric Printing Kit
- <u>Inking Plate</u> or plexiglass sheet of at least 8x10x0.5 to roll out ink
- Exacto Knife
- Painters Tape
- Watertight plastic tubs and/or gallon sized zip lock bags to hold dye projects
- Elbow length dishwashing gloves
- Clear plastic tub/bin & a cookie rack large enough to sit atop it.
- Apron/Clothing that can handle accidental dye stains
- Natural fiber textiles for dyeing at least 80% of textile content needs to be cotton, linen, silk, wool, etc. No more than 20% synthetic fibers.
 - Item's should be no larger than a jean jacket/dress/or up to 3 yards of fabric as one item.
 - For ideas, here are some of my favorite things to dye;
 - Cotton/canvas shoes (Vans, Keds)
 - White Denim
 - Dream Cotton Gauze Pieces from Faherty (often on sale)
 - PFD (Prepared for Dye) Robert Kaufmann Essex Linen
 - 1 fat quarter is already included with the workshop
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
