

Tiny Home Committee – Board Report

March 1, 2020

On behalf of the Tiny Home Village committee I am submitting this report to the REACH board.

- The MOU and a progress report were submitted to RMAPI to procure the grant dollars.
- Our MOU with City Roots Land Trust will be finalized in early March.
- An initial discussion was held with Water, Sewer and our Civil engineer. New sewer and water lines will need to be installed going into the property from the street as well as on the property. The total cost is expected to be between 125,000 to 150,000 dollars. This will include grading of the property. Next step will be to talk with RGE as to their requirements.
- Deep holes to be completed in March with a cost of approximately 1000 dollars.
- Beginning discussions with M&T, 5Star and Key Bank have occurred regarding grant money available. All are interested in the project and willing to work with us. All are asking for a site plan and a cost analysis which we are waiting on from the civil engineer and Bernie Iacovangelo.
- A meeting is scheduled this month with Deborah Campbell, CFC Director of Workforce development to clarify and define a vision for how CFC Youth Build and Tiny Homes can work collaboratively on workforce development grants.
