CHRIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH VESTRY EXPECTATION

- 1. The roles of the vestry:
 - a. Missional Mapping (strategic and visioning)
 - b. Policies and procedures
 - c. Fiduciary
 - d. Evaluation
 - e. Leadership Development
- 2. Vestry members are expected to attend worship each week as well as have a plan for intentional spiritual formation and direction.
- 3. In terms of financial giving, vestry members are to strive to make a minimum contribution of the tithe (10%) if not tithing at this time.
- 4. Vestry members will be responsible for Vestry Person of the Day (VPOD) duties for two or three months.
- 5. Vestry members are expected to attend all parish events as time permits—to be visible leaders in the community.
- 6. Each vestry member is to be in contact with ministry leaders in his or her area on a regular basis. A rule of thumb is that a vestry person needs to spend at least three hours a week outside of worship doing vestry duties. That does not mean the person has to be at the church to do the work, but in contact with ministries. Vestry members are to help ministry heads to recruit new members and to provide resources for the ministry heads.
- 7. Vestry members are to meet with the rector on a regular basis (once a month is recommended).
- 8. Vestry members are to be aware of the policies and procedures of the parish, by-laws of the parish, structure of the Episcopal Church, and vestry handbook of the Diocese of Texas.
- 9. Vestry members will attend the annual vestry retreat and/or vestry workdays.
- **10.** Delegates to Council need to be able to attend pre-council meetings or webinars scheduled by the Bishop and attend the conference on Friday and Saturday, February 10-11 in Galveston, Texas.
