

## FIRST READING <u>Psalm 68:1-10, 32-35</u>

May God arise, may his enemies be scattered; may his foes flee before him.² May you blow them away like smoke— as wax melts before the fire, may the wicked perish before God.³ But may the righteous be glad and rejoice before God; may they be happy and joyful. ⁴ Sing to God, sing in praise of his name, extol him who rides on the clouds; rejoice before him—his name is the Lord. ⁵ A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling.⁶ God sets the lonely in families, he leads out the prisoners with singing; but the rebellious live in a sun-scorched land.7 When you, God, went out before your people, when you marched through the wilderness, ⁶ the earth shook, the heavens poured down rain, before God, the One of Sinai, before God, the God of Israel.⁶ You gave abundant showers, O God; you refreshed your weary inheritance. ¹⁰ Your people settled in it, and from your bounty, God, you provided for the poor.

<sup>32</sup> Sing to God, you kingdoms of the earth, sing praise to the Lord, <sup>33</sup> to him who rides across the highest heavens, the ancient heavens, who thunders with mighty voice. <sup>34</sup> Proclaim the power of God, whose majesty is over Israel, whose power is in the heavens. <sup>35</sup> You, God, are awesome in your sanctuary; the God of Israel gives power and strength to his people. Praise be to God!

### SECOND READING Acts 1:6-14

<sup>6</sup>Then they gathered around him and asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" <sup>7</sup>He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. <sup>8</sup> But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." <sup>9</sup> After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. <sup>10</sup> They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside

them. <sup>11</sup> "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."

<sup>12</sup> Then the apostles returned to Jerusalem from the hill called the Mount of Olives, a Sabbath day's walk from the city. <sup>13</sup> When they arrived, they went upstairs to the room where they were staying. Those present were Peter, John, James and Andrew; Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew; James son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James. <sup>14</sup> They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.
