FSS is a 5-year VOLUNTARY program that assists Housing Choice Voucher residents in achieving economic independence and self sufficiency in over a five to seven year period.

- To help you identify your employment and educational goals
- Increase your jobs skills and educational level
- Assist with linking you to supportive service programs to help you achieve your long term career with livable wages

- Education, training, scholarship information
- Employment preparation and information
- Asset building which includes but not limited to Financial Literacy Counseling , budgeting, credit repair, how to balance your check book, information on 401K, IDA, etc.
- Case management/coordination, coaching and advocacy
- Empowerment, self esteem building/awareness
- Homeownership
