2023 Scholarship Program

For 2023, TSEA Scholarship Program will look different. The scholarship period for admission and completion of scholarship applications will be February 14, 2023, through March 30, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. PST. It will be a 45-day period, with no extension past that time. Scholarship applications are completely 100% Online. No paper applications are accepted.



All applications must be completed and submitted online between Feb. 14 and Mar. 30, 2023.

Awards

- Twenty-one (21) \$750 scholarships.
- A \$1000 scholarship honoring former member Debra K. Johnson for a student majoring in Criminal Justice
- Beginning in 2023, a \$1000 scholarship to honor former member Roderick Sharp for a dependent student of a TN State Trooper.
- *Applicants <u>must indicate on their</u>
 <u>application</u> that they are a criminal justice
 major or a dependant of a state trooper to
 be considered for the Debra K. Johnson or
 the Roderick Sharp awards.

To be eligible for this award, you must:



Be a high school senior or college freshman, sophomore or junior



Be one of the following:

- a dependent child of a regular or retired TSEA member who will have been a member for at least one year as of April 1, 2022.
- a regular or retired TSEA member who will have been a member for at least one year as of April 1, 2022.

OR

 a dependent child of full-time TSEA employees who will have been employed by TSEA for at least one year as of April 1, 2022.

The TSEA Scholarship Program is a great opportunity for our members and their families to receive some financial assistance for their educational pursuits. Make sure to set a reminder to submit your application for the 2023 TSEA Scholarship Program, and you could be one of the many students benefiting from this great program. The qualifying TSEA member or employee must still be active at the time awards are announced. Previous TSEA scholarship winners are NOT eligible for an award. The scholarships will be applied to tuition, fees, books, supplies and equipment required for course load at accredited, nonprofit two- or four-year colleges/universities in the United States.
