"The situation is horrible and disturbing. We are calling upon Government to intervene urgently in order to secure civil population in Panyijiar to provide food and non-food items, because all properties for the locals have been destroyed by floods," said Chiol. Last year there was massive flood due to heavy rainfall which affected almost all the states in the country, making many people displaced and crops destroyed. Subsequently with the same heavy rain this year, Jonglei State experienced the effect of early flooding which also occurred in other States such as Unity, Lakes States among others.
