Catholic High School Entrance Exam

The Catholic High School Entrance Exam takes place the first Saturday in December each year. Registration opens mid-November. Students must select the high school at which they plan to apply, then complete the exam at that school. The exam is administered by the High School Placement Test (HSPT).
