May 2018 Regional Trainings

The purpose of these trainings is to offer districts/charters a chance to network around the work they are doing to address WBF goals in their local context. After reviewing a representative sample of over 100 WBF summary reports, professionals from the Regional Education Laboratory (REL) will share their findings and point out the strengths and challenges they observed in the work around each goal. We will spend time focused on meeting teams where they are now and moving forward around the work of WBF in their setting. We recommend that each school bring a team of 2-4 people so you can take the information back to share with your leadership team.

Meetings will be held in 4 regions throughout the state, and will include:

- REL sharing findings from their review of summaries from across the state.
- Local Districts sharing and networking around successful practices.
- SMART Goal setting and Sample Goals in each area of WBF.
- Feedback from Districts/Charters on the 2017-18 Summary Review Process.
