The slaughter cows and bulls again remained mostly firm with last week's figures.

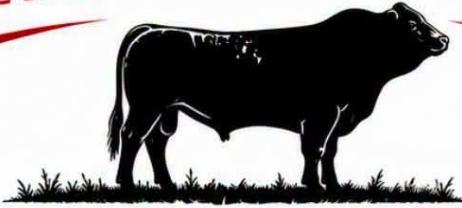

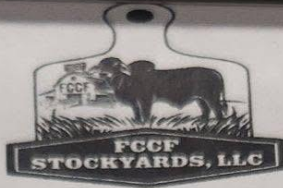

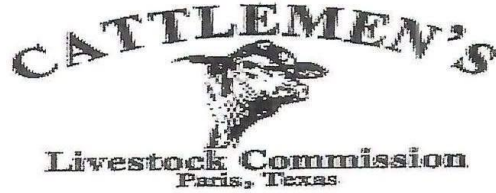
