

## Congregation Beth Torah Sukkah Use Information and Guidelines

1. Reservations are required, and if you are reading this it means you have either made or will be making one or more reservations using this link:  
<https://www.signupgenius.com/go/20F094DACA92EABFB6-sukkah> Please also use this link to remove or modify your reservation(s).
2. There are three sukkahs; a large one that can accommodate 8 people, a medium sized one that can accommodate 6 people and a small one that can accommodate 3 people. When making your reservation for a particular time slot, please indicate which of the sukkahs you want to reserve (you can reserve more than one) – there will be a check box for each of the three sized sukkahs.
3. Hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies will be available. It will be your responsibility to wipe down the table and chairs both before and after use.
4. A hand washing basin and cup will be available for use. A water spigot will be near by for you to fill the basin. It will be your responsibility to wipe down the basin and cup both before and after use.
5. A few benchers (booklet containing Grace after Meals and other content) will be available in the sukkahs in a zip locked bag. If you are uncomfortable using those, you may bring your own (and take them when you leave). If you do use the community benchers please put them back in the zip lock bag when you are done. Also available will be laminated cards with sukkot specific content.
6. A lulav and etrog will be available in the sukkahs. If you are uncomfortable using those, you may bring your own (and take them when you leave).
7. You are encouraged to bring a meal or snack for your personal consumption to enhance your celebration of the festival. Only dairy or vegetarian items will be permitted (hechsher not required). Please bring disposable plates, cups, utensils, etc. that you will need. There will be a garbage bin and a recycle bin available for your use.
8. The sukkahs are located in the inner courtyard next to the playground. Access will be from the back from the east parking lot and through the gates that let you into the courtyard/playground area (please see the attached map). You will need to walk or drive around to the back parking lot to access the sukkahs. **You will not have access to the building and there will be no access to the restrooms in the building. Masks are required when going from your parked car (or once you arrive on shul property if walking to shul) until you reach the inner courtyard.**
9. Security is being provided during the entire time the sukkahs are available for member use.
