

## **Displaying Your Science Project**

## (General Guidelines for Upper Grades)

Begin organizing your board after you have completed your investigation.

- · Your science fair project display should do two things:
  - Catch the viewer's attention so they will want to look more closely at your display. The center panel should contain the project title (lettering should be clear and large enough for someone to see from a distance)
  - 2. Explain to the viewer what you did and what you learned after completing your project.


Tip: By mounting written material, drawings, photos and other "stuff" on colored paper or poster board, then mounting it to your display board, your display board will be easier to read.


Tip - Use colored construction paper behind the white paper containing your text, adds accents to your display board.

Most Important – This is your child's project, let their talent shine. Nothing is better than a picture slightly crooked if it is done by the hand of a  $1^{st}$  grader.

Include your <u>name</u>, <u>grade</u>, <u>teacher's name</u> & <u>room number</u> on the front of your display board.
