

Course Selection

The course catalog for 2024-2025 is available on the O'Hara website. Please refer to the catalog for descriptions of the courses and their pre-requisites. Qualified students who wish to take AP Language, AP Literature, AP US History, AP Government, or AP Statistics must take a placement test as part of the application process. Please be sure to [sign up](#) for the test if you wish to take one of these courses. Course selection will begin on February 19. Students and their families are encouraged to review courses available for next year. Students are also encouraged to discuss possible classes, including levels of courses, with their teachers. Guidance counselors are available to assist in the process of selecting courses as well.

Students will receive an email to sign up for an appointment with a counselor to select their classes as well as alternate courses. Students should be sure to attend those appointments as they will need to sign up for another if they miss their appointment. Students will be given a printout of the courses that they select during the meeting. That printout must be taken home, signed by the student and the parent/guardian and returned to Academic Affairs to complete the course selection process. Students will be rostered in the order in which the signed forms are submitted to Academic Affairs.
