How does your district plan to start the year?



Appoquinimink School District

Start date: Sept. 8

Reopening plan: All students will be learning virtually for the first six weeks of school, with plans to begin hybrid learning the week of Oct. 19.

Brandywine School District

Start date: Sept. 16

Reopening plan: All students will start the year with remote learning through Nov. 6.

Caesar Rodney School District

Start date: Sept. 8

Reopening plan: The district is starting with a remote/hybrid environment during stage one of its plans for the first six weeks.

Cape Henlopen School District

Start date: Sept. 16

Reopening plan: Cape Henlopen is offering both hybrid and remote options.

Capital School District

Start date: Sept. 8

Reopening plan: All students will start the year with remote learning for the first six weeks.

Christina School District

Start date: Sept. 8

Reopening plan: All students will start the year with remote learning for the first six weeks

Colonial School District

Start date: Sept. 8.

Reopening plan: Colonial will start the year fully remote, with plans to transition to hybrid learning six weeks into the school year.

Delmar School District

Start date: Sept. 16

Reopening plan: Delmar students will learn remotely for the first quarter.

Indian River School District

Start date: Sept. 17

Reopening plan: Families will have the option of participating in hybrid or full remote instructional models for the first marking period.

Lake Forest School District

Start date: Kindergarten through third grade, as well as fourth, sixth and ninth grade will start Sept. 3. All other grades will start Sept. 8.

Reopening plan: Most Lake Forest students will start the year with remote learning. However, a small group of students will return to school under a hybrid model.

Laurel School District

Start date: Sept. 14

Reopening plan: Laurel School District will start the year with remote learning for all students, with the goal of starting hybrid instruction on Nov. 9.

Milford School District

Start date: Sept. 9

Reopening plan: Milford will start the year fully remote, and the district will provide every student with a device.

New Castle County Vo-Tech School District

Start date: Sept. 8

Reopening plan: Students in the district will start the year with remote learning for six weeks.

POLYTECH

Start date: Sept. 8 for ninth grade students, Sept. 9 for all other students

Reopening plan: Students will start the year with a hybrid learning model. This will include one day of in-person learning every week, along with four days of remote learning.

Red Clay Consolidated School District

Start date: Sept 8

Reopening plan: All students will learn virtually for the first six weeks of school,

Seaford School District

Start date: Sept. 8

Reopening plan: Seaford will start the year with hybrid learning.

Smyrna School District

Start date: Sept. 8

Reopening plan: Smyrna students will start the year virtually until Oct. 2.

Sussex Technical School District

Start date: Sept. 8 for ninth grade students, Sept. 9 for all students

Reopening plan: Students will have remote instruction, independent work and assignments five days a week through the Schoology online platform.

Woodbridge School District

Start date: Sept. 16

Reopening plan: Woodbridge parents will have the option between remote or hybrid learning.
