BPC COVID-19 Task Force
Building Use Policy for the Sanctuary End of the Building
Effective January 20, 2021

MOTION: The Balmoral Presbyterian Church COVID-19 Task Force moves to adopt the following policy for Worship and Building use for the new part of Balmoral Presbyterian Church including: the narthex, sanctuary, Classrooms a and b, choir room, sound room, long hallway and restrooms. The remainder of the building will be off-limits to Balmoral members in deference to the children of The SEED Program.

Vaccinations are encouraged but not required for attending worship and group gatherings in the choir room and classrooms a and b.

Masks are optional for fully vaccinated persons attending worship and group gatherings in the choir room and classrooms a and b.

Reservations must be made to use classrooms a and b through the BPC COVID-19 Task Force designated coordinator, Barry Dotson: barry.dotson@yahoo.com

Unvaccinated persons must wear a mask and practice social distancing in the building.

Unvaccinated children and youth must wear a mask if age 2 and older.

Hymnals will be placed in the sanctuary chairs.

All worshippers may sing hymns and participate in responsive readings.

The configuration of chairs will remain unchanged until further notice.

Worshippers may come and go from the sanctuary without direction from ushers.

Masks and hand sanitizer will be available at the entrance; hand sanitizer will be available in the restrooms.

One-page bulletins will be available at the sanctuary doors and people are asked to take them home to dispose of them.
