- **CREATION STATION:** BPC loves the children to be a part of our worship service. We invite families to allow children to join at our Creation Station which is located in the back of the sanctuary. We ask that a responsible adult sit in the back row in case a need arises.
- **PENTECOST OFFERING:** Each year on Pentecost Sunday, we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the church. The Holy Spirit remains with us still, connecting us with the church of the past, continuing to inspire the church of today, and pointing us to the church of the future. Each year, this celebration is marked by receiving the Pentecost Offering which nurtures the faith of those who are the church to come.
What we collect for the Pentecost Offering is divided into four ministry areas. 40% of the offering remains with our congregation to support ministries with children and youth in our community. 25% supports ministries with youth, ages 12-18, and those called to accompany them on a national level. 25% goes to Young Adult Volunteer experience which supports college-aged students in serving for a year in some form of ministry globally and nationally. 10% supports the "Educate a Child, Transform the World" national initiative which motivates and inspires Presbyterians to better the lives of children by joining in God's ongoing transformation of the world by working and advocating to ensure equitable, accessible, quality public education so that all children, created in the image of God, may grow into the fullness of life.

We will collect the Pentecost offering this morning during the worship service.
