Dr. Pilitsis is a Neurosurgeon with a passion for treating chronic neurological disorders that interrupt a person's day-to-day function or abilities. Illnesses that fall under this term can include chronic pain, Parkinson's Disease, Essential Tremor, Obsessive Compulsive disorders and trigeminal neuralgia.

Board-certified in neurological surgery, Dr. Pilitsis is affiliated with the Boca Raton Regional Hospital and Marcus Neuroscience Institute. She received an M.D. with distinction from Albany Medical College, a Ph.D. in physiology from Wayne State University, and an M.B.A., with a concentration in health informatics, from Fayetteville State University. Dr. Pilitsis completed residency training in neurosurgery at Wayne State University, and fellowship in functional neurosurgery from Rush University Medical Center.
