SR-133 Lane Closure For Emergency Repairs

SANTA ANA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the **southbound lane on SR-133 from Canyon Acres Dr to Forest Ave on Wednesday, January 15. The closure hours are from 8:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.** The purpose is emergency k-rail repair to prepare for the potential rain storm. This project is part of an upcoming rock-scaling operation that will last around 4 weeks. However, the work will be done during daylight behind k-rail, so no closures are expected at this time. Below is a map illustrating the lane closure.
