DECEMBER SAFETY BREAKFAST

The safety breakfast is an informal and enjoyable opportunity to network with other members of the general, construction and engineering industries while gaining free and effective safety training.

A continental breakfast will be provided, along with a safety presentation on **“Testing Water Sources - Keeping the Public Safe from Legionella.”** GFA will present on the basics of why and how to test water sources for Legionella bacteria. A person can develop Legionnaires’ disease by inhaling water mist contaminated with Legionella. Airborne exposure to environmental sources of Legionella can cause disease, especially in older and immunocompromised people. Improperly maintained water systems, such as domestic or industrial water systems or large HVAC systems, are among the leading sources of worker exposure to the bacteria that cause Legionnaires’ disease. Water heaters, cooling towers, public pools and hot tubs, water misters, decorative fountains, and warm, stagnant water can provide conditions that promote Legionella growth.
