A continental breakfast will be provided, along with a safety presentation on **“Respirable Crystalline Silica – How is your program working? Is it compliant with OSHA regulations?”** Crystalline silica has been classified as a human lung carcinogen. Many construction and general industry companies are required to have a respirable crystalline silica program. GFA will revisit OSHA’s requirements including silica basics, training requirements, employee exposure testing, and personal protective equipment. According to OSHA, silica exposure remains a serious threat to nearly 2 million U.S. workers, including more than 100,000 workers in high risk jobs such as abrasive blasting, foundry work, stonecutting, rock drilling, drywall installers, quarry work and tunneling.
