

Founded in 1909, the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference is the fifth-oldest active college athletic conference in the United States, the oldest in NCAA Division II, and the sixth to be founded after the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association, the Big Ten Conference, the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association, the Ohio Athletic Conference, and the Missouri Valley Conference. For its first 30 years, the RMAC was considered a major conference, comparable to today's NCAA Division I, before seven of its larger members left in 1938 to form the Mountain States Conference, also known as the Skyline Conference. Randy Campbell (pictured to the right) has been



the supervisor of RMAC officials since 2021. Campbell served as an official for six NCAA Division I conferences, including the Pac-12, Big 12, Western Athletic, Southland, Mountain West, and the Big Sky. He was an RMAC official from 1989 to 1995.
