LA: RISE (Los Angeles Regional Initiative for Social Enterprise) connects individuals experiencing or at risk of homelessness with paid work experience, career training, and pathways to long-term employment. LA: RISE is delivered in partnership with REDF, LA City, Employment Social Enterprises (ESE)s and America's Job Centers of California (AJCCs).

Hands-on training in high-growth industries



Up to 300 hours of paid work experience



One-on-one case management and career coaching



Job placement with high-road employers



Continued support after placement

Eligibility



Currently experiencing homelessness, formerly homeless, or at risk of homelessness



A Los Angeles County resident



18 years of age or older



Unemployed or underemployed



Interested in long-term employment and willing to work at least 300 hours with an ESE
