

## Accessing Substance Use Disorder Services at Permanent Supportive Housing Locations

**Effective July 1, 2026:** Due to curtailment of Measure A funds, Client Engagement and Navigation Services (CENS) will only be available at a limited number of permanent supportive housing (PSH) locations.

The Department of Public Health, Substance Abuse Prevention and Control, will coordinate where CENS will be provided at PSH locations based on need and available staff. PSH locations with the greatest need for substance use disorder (SUD) services may continue to have on-site services.

While on-site SUD services are shifting, a robust network of SAPC resources remains fully accessible for clients at PSH project-based and scattered sites. SUD services are available through the following:

### **Substance Abuse Service Helpline (SASH)**

24/7 toll-free helpline staffed by professionals who provide screenings, resources, and referrals to drug and alcohol treatment providers
