PASSPORT EXTENSION FAQs

Why are we offering an extension?

Due to COVID-19 all wineries had to shut down at the end of March meaning you could not visit wineries for passport tastings during that time.

How long is the extension for?

SCMWA has approved a 6 month extension for current passport holders. Your passport is now valid for 18 months instead of 12.

Who will be granted the extension?

Any consumer with a passport that expires after March 2020 will be granted a 6 month extension. Please note: this is 6 months from your current expiration date. Example: Passport originally expired June 2020, it will now expire December 2020.

Who will not be granted an extension?

If the passport expired before March 1, 2020 then it will not be granted an extension.

How do I get my extension?

When you're ready to visit a winery and use your passport for the first time, please make a reservation with participating wineries and confirm you are a passport holder. Present your passport to the winery staff at the time of your reservation. They will validate the extension for 6 months from your current expiration date.

What if I have the mobile passport app?

All current passport app purchasers have been granted the 6 month extension.
