



Safety Protocols to Limit Contact and Prevent the Spread of COVID-19:

- All attendees are encouraged to wear mask/face coverings in meeting rooms and public areas (unless outside or eating). Personal protective equipment (PPE) kits will be provided for each attendee.
- Color-coded social distancing wristbands will allow attendees to display their personal contact preferences with other attendees. The wristbands take a cue from traffic lights: Red equals no contact; yellow indicates an elbow bump is okay; green means go in for the hug or the high-five.
- All meeting rooms will be set to ensure that there will be 6 feet social distancing, as well as a place where at risk people can self isolate in the back of the room if it makes them feel more comfortable (as size of the room allows).
- All materials for the event (proceedings, program books, schedule of event, etc.) will be emailed to attendees prior to the event but also provided in an attendee bag where safety procedures were followed.
- Registration and check-in will be spread out to ensure that there will be 6 feet social distancing. Exhibitors registration and information will be done at their designated exhibit space. Exhibitors will be emailed a map prior to the conference.
- Badges for attendees will be placed on the registration table. Registration tables will be designated according to attendees last name.
- It will be stated in the preregistration email that anyone who is exhibiting symptoms should not attend in the conference and that everyone should take their temperature prior to coming to the conference (and if they are staying at the hotel, they should bring a thermometer with them) and will ask that anyone who is awaiting coronavirus test results not attend the event.
- Attendees will be monitored daily and any individuals exhibiting or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 at any time while at the event will be isolated and leave the facility as soon as practicable (required by Governor Kemp's 6/28/20 Executive Order regarding conventions).
- For contact tracing purposes, if you would like the GMP to have your cell phone number, please include it on your registration form for the meeting.

Acknowledgement of Enhanced Safety and Health Measures: Registration and attendance at, or participation in, GMP in person events constitutes an agreement by the registrant to abide by GMP and the host's property's efforts to simply with current CDC recommendations and any state of Georgia requirements. Registrants will comply with certain health and safety requests while attending the event as requested by GMP (e.g., wearing face coverings, engaging in appropriate physical distancing, not attending the event if feeling sick or showing certain symptoms, etc.) Noncompliance with GMP requests could lead to expulsion from the event with no monies refunded.
