## City of Boyne City Residential Rubbish Collection Program – 2020

<b>Spring Date</b> <b>Saturday – May 23, 2020</b>	<b>Fall Date</b> <b>Saturday - September 19, 2020</b>

The City will hold a residential rubbish collection program on the above two dates **ONLY**. This service is for all 3 unit or less residential dwellings in the city. It is not for properties outside the city nor is it for commercial businesses.

This program is in addition to, not a replacement of, your existing residential household garbage collection. It is still your responsibility to properly dispose of your garbage separately.

<b>Accepted Items - (2 cubic yards maximum)</b>	<b>Non Accepted Items</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Furniture and household furniture such as tables, lamps, mattresses, shelves</li><li>Appliances (Freon removed from freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners and dehumidifiers – sticker attached)</li><li>Toys, bicycles, sporting goods, hoses, outdoor furniture, clothing, shovels and rakes</li><li>Carpet must be cut into 4 ft. lengths rolled and secured</li><li>Window and door glass to be ducted taped</li><li>Construction debris/boards cut into 4 ft. lengths &amp; bundled</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>TV, computers, electronics, microwaves</li><li>Materials that are accepted as part of the Household Hazardous Waste Collection in Charlevoix County</li><li>Remodeling &amp; construction debris not generated at home</li><li>Earth and sod</li><li> Rocks, bricks and concrete</li><li>Vehicle parts including tires</li></ul>

On the reverse side is a detailed list of materials that are accepted and excluded from collection under this program. Materials must originate from the residence, and not from elsewhere or from residents' contractor. Materials for collection must be placed within the curb-lawn areas of right of way - that is between curb and sidewalk; or just behind curb where there is no sidewalk; or at street shoulders where there is no curb.

The total volume of all items that may be placed out for collection per house each collection is limited to two cubic yards (think of filling an area the size of a regular pick-up truck bed). Please do not place materials out at the street for collection before 5 p.m. the day before your pick-up. **Pick-up will start at 7 a.m. sharp, so have any items out by then. If your items are not out by 7 a.m., there will not be an opportunity for a second pickup in your area.**
