



"Boyne Thunder July Exhibit: "All Things Watercraft" Call To Artists Information and Application

Vision: This Exhibit will showcase artists of different mediums artwork inspired by Boyne Thunder. The goal is to have as many renditions as possible of travel on the water. This can include Kayaks, sailboats, jet skis, canoes, and anything in-between including Cigarette boats! Maybe you already know someone's who's watercraft you would like to paint.

Exhibit Dates: Monday, July 1st – Wednesday, July 31st, 2024, with Opening Reception on Saturday, June 29th, 2024, from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. with wine and hors d'oeuvres.

This Exhibit will be Juried.

Call to Artists: Each applicant can submit one piece. Applications and fees (*if you are not a member*) will be accepted Monday, April 15, 2024, through Friday, May 31, 2024. You have until Saturday, June 15, 2024, to submit a photo of your completed artwork for the juror's process.

Application Fee & Commission Split:

BAC Members: Members do not pay a fee and your application along with the Call to Artists will automatically be emailed to you. Simply complete and submit your application directly to boynearts@gmail.com. Sale of art is 70/30 split which 30% goes to BAC.

Non-Members application fee is \$35.00, and sale of art is 70/30 split with 30% going to BAC. Please submit your application and fee to www.boynearts.org or stop into the Boyne Arts located at One Water Street, Suite 203, Boyne City, above Cafe Sante'. Entry is next to the Alpine Chocolate Haus under the green awning (2nd floor).

Application Process: All participants must submit a photo of your completed artwork to boynearts@gmail.com no later than Saturday, June 15, 2024. The jury will make their decision within one week from receiving your email. You will be notified by email of their decision.

Acceptable Mediums: Oils, Watercolors, Acrylics, Pastels, Sculptures, Pen and Ink, Charcoal, Fiber Art, Glass, Photography and Colored Pencils. For those who choose painting as their medium your piece must be framed unless you have chosen a gallery wrap which measures 1.5"-2". Sides of gallery wrap canvas/boards must be painted. Artwork must have wire on the back for hanging, no Sawtooth's.

Delivery/Pick-up of Artwork: Please deliver your completed artwork to the Boyne Arts Center no later than Tuesday, June 25th, 2024. Artwork will be hung June 26th and 27th. Pick up your artwork Thursday, August 1, 2024, through August 4th, 2024.

You have until Saturday, June 15, 2024, to submit your photo for the juror's process to a separate email; boynearts@gmail.com.

If you prefer you may also stop in the BAC and pick up and submit your application and fee to Boyne Arts Center. We are located at One Water Street, Suite 203, Boyne City, MI. 49712. Note payments must be postmarked no later than May 31, 2024.
