Minimum 6 students per class required; any individual class date that does not meet the minimum will be canceled. Maximum 10 students per class.

Jennie Kimbrough is an artist in Boyne City, MI. She received her B.F.A. in 2004 from Missouri State University, and attended Wichita State University for graduate studies from 2005-2006. Her studio practice focuses on painting with acrylic and encaustic, as well as mixed media work. Her work has been featured in solo and group shows across the country, and has work in many private collections, as well as the collection of UTMB Galveston Hospital.
