



December 14, 2019 has been declared National Wreaths Across America Day!

In 2007, the Worcester family, along with veterans and others who had helped with their annual Christmas wreath ceremony in Arlington, formed Wreaths Across America, to continue and expand this effort and support other groups around the country who wanted to do the same. This nonprofit organization continues the Arlington tradition as part of its mission to Remember, Honor and Teach. In 2018, Wreaths Across America and their national network of volunteers laid over 1,204,000 memorial wreaths at over 1,400 locations in all 50 States, with ceremonies at sea, and at each of the national cemeteries on foreign soil! This was accomplished with help from 2,800 fundraising groups, many corporate contributions, and donations of trucking, shipping, and thousands of helping hands. Their annual pilgrimage from Harrington, Maine to Arlington National Cemetery is known as the world's largest veteran's parade, stopping at schools, monuments, veteran's homes and communities all along the way to remind people how important it is to Remember, Honor and Teach.

The Bay Township Area Cemeteries (BTAC) group is proud to be an official location for Wreaths Across America!

The Bay Township Cemetery Committee teamed up with the Horton Bay United Methodist Church (HBUMC) in 2014 to form the BTAC group. In our 6th year, there are currently **50** known veterans buried in our 3 cemeteries in Bay Township and the Cremains Garden at the HBUMC. Our goal is to place a wreath on the grave of every veteran in our cemeteries: Oaklawn Cemetery on Horton Bay Rd. N., Dyer Cemetery on Camp Daggett, North Bay Cemetery on Church Rd. and the Cremains Garden at the church. Your wreath sponsorship places a wreath on a Veteran's grave and helps to fund Veteran and educational outreach. **Each wreath is only \$15.00. For every 2 wreaths that are ordered, an additional one will be received to be placed on a veteran's grave along with the 7 Ceremonial Wreaths.** When you donate you can choose from several options: You may specify the veteran on whose grave you would like the wreath placed, or sponsor "in honor of" or "in memory of" a veteran, or you may let the BTAC group decide for you where the wreath will be placed. **Please call Georganna Monk (Location Coordinator) at 231-883-9867 if you have any questions about sponsoring wreaths, how to obtain a sponsorship form, or to volunteer. If we surpass our goal, the remaining wreaths will be applied to 2020. **Sponsorship deadline is Monday, December 2, 2019.** All wreaths are sent directly to the Bay Township location and none are sent to the individuals purchasing sponsorships.

Please plan to attend the Wreath Laying Ceremony at Dyer Cemetery on Saturday, December 14, 2019 at 11:45 (Sharp). You do not have to be a wreath sponsor to attend. The Boyne City American Legion Ernest Peterson Post 228 will be assisting at this ceremony. It will be a very special time to be able to honor these men and women by placing a wreath that will mark their grave until the following Spring.

Remember. Honor. Teach. On Saturday, December 14, 2019 at 11:45, following a short ceremony, we will place the Ceremonial Wreaths and then the wreaths on all of our 50 veteran's graves beginning at Dyer Cemetery on Camp Daggett Road. We will then go to North Bay Cemetery on Church Road; next we will place a wreath on the grave of our one veteran in Oaklawn Cemetery on Horton Bay Road North, and lastly, one wreath will be placed at the Cremains Garden at the Horton Bay United Methodist Church.
