Dr. Christina Loiacono (Low ya' ca no) is a graduate of the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine and completed a residency in Veterinary Anatomic Pathology at the University of Missouri-Columbia where she also received a PhD. Dr. Loiacono joined the National Veterinary Services Laboratories in 2005 as a veterinary pathologist focused on foreign animal disease diagnostics and education. Dr. Loiacono currently leads a network of 60 Federal, State and University-associated animal diagnostic laboratories across the US providing surveillance and outbreak response testing for 14 diseases of high consequence.
