## KEY DECISIONS & ACTION TO MOVE FORWARD





**The Focus of This Group:** Take action to better coordinate existing navigation and wraparound services to support community members to attain a credential along the journey to earning a self-sufficient wage



**The Target Populations:** Three target populations for this group to focus their work were identified, including:

Latinx/People of Color

Opportunity Youth or youth who may become opportunity youth

Single Parents



**The Initial Action Areas:** Three critical initial areas for action were determined and small groups were formed to move work forward in each before the next larger session. If you are interested in participating in these small groups, please contact Matt Horn.



1) Aligning Software: Determine which software platforms navigators and case managers are using to manage casework/support community members along their journey AND develop a recommendation for the action team on which make sense for aligned use across our region (for example, MyColoradoJourney)



**2)** Performance Metrics: Determine which performance metrics this group will track towards impact



3) Understanding & Coordinating Funding: Map and support coordination of all funding sources that can support this work (including American Rescue Plan Act dollars).

The Backbone Team will support a coordinated effort to:

- a) Identify organizations receiving funding

- b) Gain clarity on how these organizations plan to utilize the funding
  - A survey will be sent out by the Backbone Team to these organizations by Friday, August 13th to gain clarity on their plan for utilizing public funding
- c) Support those who are interested to coordinate their efforts



**4)** Increasing Coordinated Referrals: A need was identified for better coordinating referrals between navigation and wraparound service providers to support community members to access critical services along their journey to earning a skill or credential.

Pay equity for women and people of color in critical industries (such as Early Childhood Education)

- Work Already Underway: The Rocky Mountain Partnership is issuing a call to action and developing a toolkit for all employers in the community to improve equity in their job posting, hiring, and retention practices, going above and beyond what is mandated by Colorado's Equal Pay for Equal Work Act, to improve equity for women and people of color in all industries.
- This will be lifted to RMP's <u>Policy and Legislative Advisory</u> <u>Network</u> for them to determine action that can be taken

More funding to support students experiencing emergency situations

- The Backbone Team mapping and supporting coordination of all funding sources that can support this collective work (as outlined on Page 2, Action 3)
- This will be lifted to RMP's <u>Funding Alignment Network</u> to support funding towards work that will have an impact on the Partnership's shared targets

Additional scholarship money to serve more students

This will be lifted to the Funding Alignment Network to support funding towards work that will have an impact on the Partnership's shared targets
