<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Button-down dress shirt, polo shirt, turtle neck, or sweater<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Dress pants</li><li>- Dress shoes</li></ul></li><li>- Ties are optional, but encouraged<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- No cologne</li></ul></li><li>- No T-shirts, sweatshirts</li><li>- No jeans, sweatpants</li><li>- No athletic shoes</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Dress or skirt that reaches the knees</li><li>- Dress shirt, blouse, turtleneck, or sweater.</li><li>- No Spaghetti straps. Shoulders must be covered.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Dress slacks or pants</li></ul></li><li>- Dress shoes or dress sandals<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- No perfume</li></ul></li><li>- No T-shirt, sweatshirts</li><li>- No jeans, sweatpants</li><li>- No athletic shoes or flip-flops</li></ul>
