I will be hosting a discussion about direct imaging of solder mask. Yes, I said solder mask, as most of my presentations surround this topic. I feel it's important for everyone to understand the differences between DI, LDI and flood light. To this day it surprises me how many people are unfamiliar with, or are not aware of the differences. And believe me, there are differences.

My discussion will not only be about the Solder Mask (SM), but also about the equipment to process SM. We will discuss "wave lengths" and "peaks" that are very important when processing these inks. Most solder masks to date have been built around flood light exposing and process very slowly. Often the DI and LDI units will not fully prepare the SM for the upcoming developing step.
