Area 10 is offering to intermediate/advanced ringers the option of a **Bronze Conference Choir** instead of the usual workshops. Participation is by application (separate document): rehearsals begin Friday and culminate in a concert on Saturday evening.

Our concerts are:

- Friday Evening: Handbells Unlimited!
- Saturday Evening: Showcase concert featuring: Your handbell choir, ensemble or soloist, The Bell Tree Orchestra, and the Bronze Conference Choir.
- Sunday Afternoon: The closing concert featuring all ringing participants in the Massed Choir, Willamette Division Choir, Columbia Division Choir and the Bronze Conference Choir.

Registration Fee for the 2017 conference is \$195/ringer before April 15th, after April 15th the fee will be \$220/ringer.

The massed ringing piece *Divenire* is composed by Matthew Compton, the new Artistic Director of Bells of the Cascades.

Housing will be in Weatherford Hall, a traditional dorm on the OSU campus. With meals taken in the Student Dining Facility.

“Reunion” special activities will be planned throughout the weekend, to help enliven and jog memories.
