

Handling Bell Changes

I'm having a panic attack – I have to change bells! Don't stress out about it. Come work on techniques to do it smoothly and effortlessly. After some generic exercises, we will look at specific examples in the conference music and discuss the smoothest ways to make the changes.

Please bring gloves, 4 bells, and conference music.

3. **Percussion Basics for Handbells**, taught by Dennis Dell

This workshop will teach ringing and mallet techniques.

Please bring a set of mallets and 2 handbells.

4. **Polish & Repair**, taught by Marlene Anderson from Malmark Handbells

This is a technical workshop covering how to completely disassemble the bell; clean it inside and out; clean all parts; replace/repair springs, missing washers, screws, etc.; polish the brass; and reassemble the bell.

Please Note: Malmark wants us to know that it will send someone to any bell choir for a private Polish & Repair workshop. Just ask!
