

2026 Senegal Go Team Prayer Itinerary

Tuesday, February 3...The journey begins today at 4:45 AM when the team meets at PDX for their 7:00 AM flight. Prior to heading to their gate, there will be a group prayer at 5:10 AM in front of Portland Coffee Roasters near the Delta ticket counter. The team flies first to JFK International, where they will have dinner and then board their flight to Senegal.

Scripture: Joshua 1:9

Pray for the team's safe travel and good health. Help their hearts and minds to be open as God prepares them for the journey ahead. Pray for travel mercies and for their bodies to adjust to the 8-hour time difference.

Wednesday, February 4... This morning, the team lands at Blaise Diagne International outside of Thiès, Senegal. Leopold Diouf will meet them at the airport. They will exchange their US dollars for West African Francs (CFA), and purchase bottled water. After freshening up, they will spend the afternoon in Thiès visiting Bartimee Hospital and hearing about project Nicodemus from Leo. The team will be tired but will also be excited when they arrive in Senegal. They are eager to see what God has in store for them over the next two weeks.

Scripture: II Corinthians 3:3-6

Pray that God will give the team the stamina and grace they need, so that each person they encounter on their journey may see God's love through them.

Thursday, February 5...The team will start their day by as they travel to Dakar to meet with the World Vision Senegal staff and will meet with CAPRO, a mission organization in the afternoon.

Scripture: Philippians 4:4

Pray for the team as they meet new people at World Vision Senegal, learn about new projects, and continue to adjust to the time difference.

Friday, February 6... The team will meet with staff from Mission Inter Senegal (MIS) and visit the Huffman School.

Scripture: Hebrews 10:24-25

Pray for Mission Inter Senegal staff, and their continued outreach into Senegal with church planting, and for the staff, administrators, teachers, and students at the Huffman School; that they would all feel the Holy Spirit at work in their work.

Saturday, February 7... The team spends the day with our friends in Kollore Gui – the original group of villages where CPCs relationships first began in Senegal in 1999. They will meet with the federation leaders, and drive outside of the villages to see the first well that CPC helped fund and tour the community market garden.

Scripture: John 4:7-19

Pray for our friends in Kollore Gui who now have clean, accessible water and that more of them will open their hearts to the life-giving water of the Gospel. Pray for the community market garden; that it will grow and flourish, providing a new source of food for the villagers.

Sunday, February 8... The team will attend worship with Leo and other community members at a Christian church in Thiès. After the service, they will meet with the church leaders to discuss progress on the new church construction and other programs and activities.

Scripture: Psalm 23 1-8

Pray for the leaders and congregants of this church in Thiès, and for all of the churches in Senegal. Being a Christian in a country that is nearly 95 percent Muslim has its challenges. Pray for Sylvie (Adama's widow) and her children, and for Adele (Leo's wife) and her children – that God will continue to bless them and that they will know the love and support of families and friends, including CPC. Pray for the Go Team, that God will help them to relax and refresh on this Sabbath, so that they may feel the love and presence of Jesus for the rest of their trip.

Monday, February 9...The team will travel about 5 hours to Koungeul to visit the World Vision Area Project region of Lour-Ribot. This is the region where CPC has over 70 sponsored children. Along the way the team will stop to visit a medical clinic that is run by Mission Inter Senegal (MIS) so that the team can see another arm of their work.

Scripture: Acts 1: 8

Pray for safe travel and health for all travelers. Pray that we shine the light of Christ in all circumstances. Help us to see God at work in Senegal.

Tuesday, February 10... The team is in Lour-Ribot today. They will spend time with World Vision staff to learn more about the work being done in Lour-Ribot. The team will visit a school, talk with teachers, and meet with villagers. The highlight of the day is sure to be meeting and spending time with their sponsored children.

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 3: 6-7

Pray for the World Vision staff, who work diligently in this community to enact and influence positive change and community development, and for the 70 sponsored children who have a direct connection to CPC. Pray that when the team meets their sponsored child/children that they will be able to see and feel the love of God, feel encouraged to continue to grow, and that they will find upward mobility in Senegalese society.

Wednesday, February 11... The team will spend another full day in Lour-Ribot today. They will spend more time with World Vision staff to learn more about the work being done in Lour-Ribot. The team will visit another school, a health clinic, and meet with villagers. The region of Lour-Ribot is vast; with the community at the early stages of development, the team will have a lot of terrain to cover and many development sites to visit.

Scripture: Matthew 19:13-15

Pray for the people of Lour-Ribot and the World Vision staff working together to help improve food security and access to clean water. Pray for the health and safety of children and mothers in particular, and that there will be sufficient, well-trained teachers for the schools.

Thursday, February 12...On their last day in Lour-Ribot, the team will meet with World Vision staff and debrief their visit. They will then travel 5 hours back to Thiès.

Scripture: Colossians 1:9-11

Pray for the stamina of the World Vision staff; that they feel inspired to continue to encourage community leaders and other villagers to take part in the programs that are offered. Pray for the entire Area Project region of Lour-Ribot, and all of its inhabitants, that through these programs they will, little by little, come to know the Lord.

Friday, February 13...The team departs from Blaise Diagne International at 11:30 AM, flying direct to JFK International, where the team will have dinner and catch their next flight at 7:55 PM to Seattle, and then to PDX. With God's grace they will land at PDX around 12:15am on Saturday, February 14.

Scripture: Romans 15:13

Pray for safe travels. Give thanks for the team's time in Senegal, and those supporting the team back at home. Thank God for the Senegalese people the team met along the way that touched each of them in a special way. Fill us, Lord, with Your joy and hope.
