For our own Amherst priorities: Do we want to continue to focus on affordable housing, climate action and sustainability, the health of the Connecticut River and its watershed, racial justice, single payer healthcare, and the current task force's review of town government? Think about whether you would like to see us add (or subtract) a priority.
