As we approach the back-to-school season, many families in Brevard County are focused on getting their kids ready for the classroom. However, amidst the hustle and bustle of shopping for school supplies, it is important to address a critical issue: hunger among our children.

While school supplies are a top priority, we must not overlook the fundamental need for nourishment.

Without proper nutrition, children cannot thrive academically, physically, or emotionally.



It is our collective responsibility to ensure that no child in Brevard County goes to school hungry.

The overall percentage of students who receive free and reduced price meals in our county has reached



an increase from last year's percentage of 56.6%! This indicates a significant portion of our community is struggling to meet their basic food needs.

The growing need, by the numbers...

2021/22

44 schools / 2,900 students served



2022/23 57 schools / 3,900+ students served





These figures highlight the urgency of the situation and the need for collective action to address this pressing issue.

Disturbingly, food insecurity impacted 12% of Brevard County children in 2021. This means that a significant number of children in our county are unsure of where their next meal will come from. Furthermore. among food insecure children in Brevard County, 72% reside in households with income at or below the poverty line, while 28% are likely ineligible for federal nutrition programs. These statistics paint a bleak picture of the challenges faced by our most vulnerable community members.

The thought of sending a child home from school on a Friday not knowing if they will have enough nourishment to get them through the weekend keeps me awake at night. It's a heart-wrenching reality that many children in Brevard County face every week. But together, we can make a difference.

I am reaching out to you today because I know we have much work to do in Brevard County, and I'm hopeful I can count on you. We have set an ambitious goal for the month of August: to get an additional 100 children sponsored for the school year. That means we need to raise \$19,000 to cover the added food cost!
