## WHO WE ARE:

Family Promise of Tualatin Valley serves families experiencing homelessness from the Tigard-Tualatin, Sherwood, Lake Oswego and West Linn school districts. Our network of eighteen civic and religious organizations help us to provide shelter, meals and a supportive community for our guests 365 days per year.

## SOME FACTS:

- 27% of Oregon's children have parents that lack secure employment
- 32% live in households where there is a high housing cost burden
- In Clackamas County, ODOE reported that 1,542 students were identified as homeless during the last school year
- Keeps children at their schools
- Due to Covid, there is limited rental assistance
- FPTV is the largest shelter in WA county
- FPTV keeps families together

Items needed: choose to buy a few items or put together the entire basket on your own, with your ministry, family, or friends. Bring a smile to a family.

### KITCHEN

- dish soap
- dish washer detergent
- 2 kitchen sponges
- comet cleanser or Bar Keepers Friend
- all purpose cleaner
- wipes for surface cleaning
- large zip lock bags
- small zip lock bags
- Saran Wrap or Press & Seal
- aluminum foil
- 2 rolls paper towels
- tall kitchen trash bags
- package paper plates - 10.5 "
- plastic disposable cups
- box of disposable plastic ware
- 2 kitchen towels
- kitchen oven mitt
- 2 pot holders

### BATH:

- 4 rolls toilet paper
- box Kleenex
- Bar bath soap or body wash
- 2 liquid soap filled dispenser for hands

### LAUNDRY:

- Tide Pods or laundry detergent
- **Sturdy** laundry basket (please place all other items in the basket)
