


"The Secret Game" presentation by Scott Ellsworth

Scott Ellsworth has written about race relations in the United States for the New York Times, the Washington Post, and the Los Angeles Times. Formerly a historian at the Smithsonian Institution, he is also the author of *Death in a Promised Land*, the first comprehensive history of the

Tulsa race riot of 1921, the worst single incident of racial violence in American history. He now lives with his wife and their fourteen-year-old twin sons in Ann Arbor, where he teaches at the University of Michigan.
