- the KEYNOTE interface
- the types of slides available
- animation effects
- embedding video into a slide (avoids lost class time trying to go to the internet to show a video)
- use of the keynote remote on iPad or iPhone which adds additional functionality for an interactive presentation

Please bring you Apple computer to the session and a flash drive. After the Monday session, the Thursday session will allow us to review the techniques that you practiced and address any questions that you have.
