

OLLI VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR MANNA FOODBANK TEAM

PROVIDING TENS OF THOUSANDS OF MEALS A DAY TO THE HUNGRY

PROGRAM SPECIFICS:

- **WHY IT MATTERS:** Hunger is a continuing and pervasive problem in WNC. MANNA is the major food distribution center for 16 counties, providing about 38,000 meals a day to people who would otherwise go hungry. MANNA volunteers add an additional 33 full time staff equivalents: MANNA could not succeed without us.
- **WHEN:** The third Friday of every month from 1 to 3 p.m.
- **VOLUNTEER ROLE:** Sorting and repacking food from pallets or bulk food into packages appropriate for individual families, schoolchildren for weekend meals, or distribution to food kitchens in WNC.
- **YOUR COMMITMENT:** Two hours a month.
- **QUALIFICATION:** Volunteers work in a warehouse, generally standing for 2 hours with a break. Must be able to stand, bend, and lift cans or boxes of food and enjoy the fellowship and the work.
