PROGRAM SPECIFICS:

- WHY IT MATTERS: Nearly every other day, Asheville's Homeward Bound successfully places a person experiencing homelessness in housing. From Homeward Bound's Welcome Home Center, clients are provided with basic furniture and a complete set of household goods to help them get established and feel at home. These items have been donated by the public and local businesses.

- VOLUNTEER ROLE: Assist the Center's manager with a range of tasks, primarily associated with helping donors bring in items and organizing the materials that case managers will be taking to the new residents.
- YOUR COMMITMENT: Availability on 1st or 3rd Thursdays, approximately once every 2-3 months
- QUALIFICATION: Ability to stand for 2 hours and handle light lifting of donors' items. A separate Center crew handles furniture donations.
