



THREE opportunities for College for Seniors Instructor Support and How to Register

1. Creating Simple Power Point Presentations for Your College for Seniors Course

Tuesdays, February 28 and March 7
10 a.m. - noon

This two-session workshop will demonstrate how to construct and use a simple Power Point presentation for use when teaching at College for Seniors. Learn how to collect and add illustrations, movies and text to your presentations. We will construct sample presentations and learn how to use them to make your classes more interesting and effective. There will be two two-hour sessions with a week in between so you will have time between sessions to work on your presentation.

2. Accelerated “Speak Out, Speak Up” for College for Seniors instructors

Saturdays, March 4 and March 11
9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Based on the College for Seniors course by the same name, this two-session class will help hone your presentation skills. Many speakers and teachers assume that if they know their topic, they'll be successful. However, how well you engage your listeners and project competence and believability are much more important. This class will feature videotaping your presentation with individual feedback and coaching to help you take your personal teaching style to a higher level of success, no matter whether you're a novice or an “old hand” at teaching.
