PROGRAM SPECIFICS:

- **WHY IT MATTERS:** Asheville juxtaposes wealth and want, with high-end restaurants and residences sitting alongside a hurting homeless population. Haywood Street Congregation offers a suite of services to Asheville's homeless, including restaurant-quality meals served twice a week at its Downtown Welcome Table, clothing, counseling services, a community garden, links to social services and much more. Above all, Haywood Street helps build dignity and hope for people who are struggling.
- **WHEN:** A wide range of volunteer opportunities, typically involving about two hours, are available most days of the week, with a strong need on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Sundays.
- **VOLUNTEER ROLE:** Examples include food preparation and serving, helping in the clothes closet, gardening, serving as a companion to residents recovering from recent medical treatment, providing haircuts, assisting homeless artists, and helping with communications and marketing. - **QUALIFICATION:** The willingness to treat everyone with dignity, help others, make new friends and build community.
