French Broad Ave., will be offering a selection of open captioned films each Sunday beginning Sunday, Feb. 3, and continuing for the foreseeable future (open captions appear directly on the screen, like the subtitles for foreign films). Four open captioned films will be shown at various times today, Sunday, February 3: "Green Book," "Stan & Ollie," "The Wife" and "Vice." Check their website for the exact times for these films, as well as for the schedule for open captioned films on subsequent Sundays.

The general policy of the Grail Moviehouse is as follows: ON SUNDAYS, we will run the first showtime of the day with open captions for each movie when it is available. Since not all films are available with open captions, it is best to check their website for specific films.

The Grail Moviehouse is also in the process of purchasing assistive listening devices for all three of the screens at the theater. You can check their website to see when this equipment is up and running.
