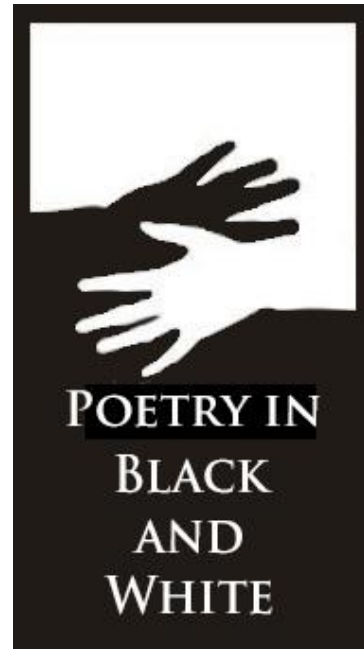


Poetry in Black and White
