After-school programs for middle school students

PROGRAM SPECIFICS

- **Why it matters:** In Real Life (IRL) provides after-school programs for Asheville City Schools middle school students.
- **When:** Spring Session is Feb. 19 – May 4, 2018. Programming runs Monday through Friday, 3:30–5 p.m. Study hall follows programming each day from 5–5:45 p.m.
- **Volunteer role:** IRL volunteers actively support and interact with middle school students participating in the program. Additionally, volunteers assist with logistics and support providers. After the program, volunteers are encouraged to help students with homework during study hall.
- **Your commitment:** Suggested time commitment is 1.5 hours (3:30–5 p.m.) one day per week for the duration of the program session (Feb. 19 – May 4). Volunteers may commit to an additional 45 minutes to 1 hour for assisting students with homework.
- **Qualification:** Be ready to actively engage with middle school students. Prior volunteer experience with middle school students preferred but not required.
