Volunteers Needed

Dates: Roughly the end of school in June to the start of school in Aug.

Days: Monday through Fridays, roughly 8 or 9 weeks (not July 4)

Times: Lunch time – serve for one hour, need time for set up & cleanup

Signups : Can sign up for one day, but better to sign up for a certain day, like all Mondays at one site

Program Description:

1. Buncombe Ct School System prepares and delivers hot lunches to designated high poverty neighborhood sites, for volunteers to distribute free to children ages 2-18 and to the disabled.
2. Online background checks are required of all volunteers. A training video of 40 minutes with 6 questions is required.
3. Two people can adequately cover the feeding site.
