Stay Healthy, and Safe

Below are some simple food safety
guidelines for your meals.

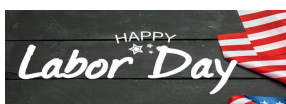
- Wash your hands before eating the meal
- Cold meals should be eaten immediately or refrigerated within 2 hours or receiving the meal.
- Foods like dairy (milk, cheese, etc.) and meats should be quickly refrigerated at a temperature of 41°F or Lower.
- Hot meals should be held at a minimum temperature of 135°
- Hot foods should be reheated to a minimum temperature of 165°F or higher before eating.
- Any leftovers from the meal should be thrown out after 5 days of receiving it! Throw out any meal that is left out for 4 hours or longer at room temperature.
